What Is MOAA?

The Military Officers Association of America was founded in 1929 and is headquartered in Alexandria, VA. Some 360,000 members make it the country's largest and most influential military officers organization. What has MOAA accomplished recently?

- Became the driving force behind TRICARE for Life
- Won major survivor benefit upgrades for deaths on active Guard/Reserve duty
- Established statutory protection for commissary benefit
- Spearheaded the campaign to end SBP "widows tax"
- Won permanent health coverage for all drilling Guard/Reserve members and families.

Any person commissioned by the uniformed services or the National Guard/Reserve, or any other reserve components of the services is eligible.

Wichita Chapter

The Wichita Chapter was organized in 1959 and affiliated with the national office of MOAA that same year. Today, more than 250 members in South Central Kansas belong to the chapter.
